• Charge the baby soother for 10 hours before initial use.

Safety instructions

Baby soother setup and use:

- Place the baby soother on a flat surface, such as a dresser, bureau, or shelf.
- NEVER place the baby soother or cords within the cot.

- Adult assembly is required. Keep small parts away from children when assembling.

- Keep this User Guide for future reference.
- · Keep the cords out of reach of children.
- Do not cover the baby soother with a towel or blanket.
- Test this baby soother and all its functions so that you are familiar with it prior to actual use.
- Do not use the baby soother in damp areas or close to water.
- Do not install the baby soother in extreme cold or heat, direct sunlight, or close to a heat source.
- Do not touch the plug contacts with sharp or metal objects.
- Connect the power adapters to easily accessible power outlet.

There is a risk of explosion if the battery is replaced by an incorrect type. Dispose of used batteries according to the instructions.

1. Getting started

Location

Important

Do not place your S1 in the bathroom or other humid areas.


Place your baby soother within reach of the AC power outlet and wall socket. The socket-outlet should be installed near the equipment and should be easily accessible.

Connecting and charging the baby soother

Important

Warning! Use only the approved rechargeable built-in Lithium battery supplied with the S1.

- 1. Plug the supplied USB type-C cable into the USB-C power socket.
- Plug the USB-C power cable into the power jack on the back of the baby soother.
- Switch on the AC power (if your AC power outlet has a switch). The battery charging LED indicator will light up in red and turn off when the batteries are fully charged.



Battery low warning

If the battery charging LED indicator flashes red, it means the battery level is low and needs recharging.

Battery performance

When charging the batteries for the first time, charge for at least 10 hours continuously. In normal conditions, A fully charged battery should provide up to 50 hours of usage time. For detailed information on battery performance, see Technical Specifications on page 13.


Note that new batteries do not reach their full capacity until they have been put to normal use for several days.

The charge capacity of the rechargeable batteries will reduce with time as it wears out, giving the baby soother less usage / standby time.

Your S1 is now ready for use.

2. Getting to know your baby soother

Overview of your baby soother





A Light ball

B Light on/off control

- · Press once to turn on the light.
- · Press once to dim the light when the light is already on.
- · Press and hold to turn off the light.

C Mood/Night light control


- · Press once to increase the brightness of the light.
- When the light is turned on, press and hold to change the light colors.
 There are 8 colors to choose from.

D Speaker

E Red battery LED indicator

- It turns on when the battery is charging.
- If the baby soother is connected to the power supply, it will turn on when charging begins and turn off after charging is complete.
- If the baby soother is not connected to the power supply, it will flash red when the battery level is low.

F Power jack (USB type-C)



G Volume control

- · Press once to turn on the sound.
- Press once to lower the volume when the sound is already on.
- · Press and hold to turn off the sound.

H Soothing sound control

- Press once to increase the volume when the sound is already on.
- When the sound is turned on, press and hold to change the sound.
 There are 10 soothing sounds/lullabies to choose from.

I Sleep timer switch

Select between 30 minutes, 90 minutes or off.

J Light switch

Select between fixed color mode or color cycling mode.

K Power ON/OFF switch

- Switch on the power and the S1 will be in standby mode.
- Switch off the power and both the light and sound will be off.

Note

- No key presses will work when switched off.
- S1 is delivered with power off setting. When you use it, please switch it on.


3. Before use

3.1 Intended use

Be aware that this portable baby soother is only intended as an aid. It is not a substitute for responsible and proper adult supervision.

3.2 Setup location

 Do not place the baby soother or cords in the crib or within reach of the baby. The baby soother and cords should be more than 1 meter (3 feet) away from the baby and crib.



 Make sure the baby soother is not placed near other electrical equipment to avoid interference. Move it 2 meters (6 feet) away from other electrical equipment.


3.3 Check the speaker's volume

Adjust the speaker volume of the baby soother to the desired volume when necessary. See section 4.5 for volume level settings.

4. Using the baby soother

4.1 Set the light mode, sleep timer and power on/off mode



- Light control: slide the switch to select between fixed color mode or color cycling mode. See section 4.3 for more information.
- Sleep timer: slide the switch to select between 30 minutes, 90 minutes or off. When the time is up, the light and sound will turn off.
- Power on/off: slide the switch to power on/off. When powered on, the S1
 will be in standby mode. When powered off, both the light and sound will
 be off, but battery charging still works.

4.2 Turn the light/sound on or off

When the power on/off slide switch is in the ON position, press \circlearrowleft once on the corresponding side of the S1 to turn on the light/sound. Press and hold the button to turn it off.

4.3 Light control

- When fixed mode is selected, press and hold to change to the next color. There is a night light (warm white) and 7 mood light colors (red, orange, yellow, green, cyan, blue, purple) to choose from.
- When cycling mode is selected, the light color will change automatically in sequence to white, red, orange, yellow, green, cyan, blue, purple and so on.
 The color will change every 5 seconds automatically. As the light changes to the next color, it will fade in within 1 second.
- Press * once to increase the brightness. Press * once to decrease the brightness. There are 5 brightness levels to choose from

4.4 Soothing sound control

When the sound is on, press and hold

to change to the next soothing sound/lullaby. There are 10 sounds/lullabies to choose from. They are Lullaby 1, Lullaby 2, Lullaby 3, Brown noise, White noise, Fan, Waves, Rain, Bird song and Womb pulse.

4.5 Adjust the sound/speaker volume

When the sound is on, press \circlearrowleft once to decrease the volume. Press \checkmark once to increase the volume. There are 5 volume levels to choose from.

5. Help

The light ball / battery LED Indicator does not turn on.

- Slide the power switch to the ON position. Press () once to turn it on.
- Connect the baby soother to the power supply to recharge it.

The battery LED indicator flashes.

· The battery level is low and needs recharging.

Unable to hear the sound from the speaker.

 The volume level may be set too low. Increase the volume level of the baby soother. See section 4.5 for volume level settings.

Cleaning and care

Important

Always switch off and disconnect the power adapter before cleaning your portable baby soother.

- Clean your baby soother with a slightly damp cloth or with an anti-static cloth. Never use cleaning agents or abrasive solvents.
